SPARSH

The journey from a real classroom to a virtual classroom was quite challenging for Deepshikha, ICD&MH. It was a big question as in how children with intellectual challenges will be able to learn through a virtual platform. But we decided to give it a try.

Like other regular schools, online classes were planned and designed so that we continue their education and skill development. We redesigned our curriculum based on the needs and goals of the child.

Classes were divided into 4 sections:

- a. Basic and primary learning - Primary group
- b. Focused Academic learning – Academic learning
- c. Skill development- Shining group
- d. Adult learning and leisure group: Secondary Group

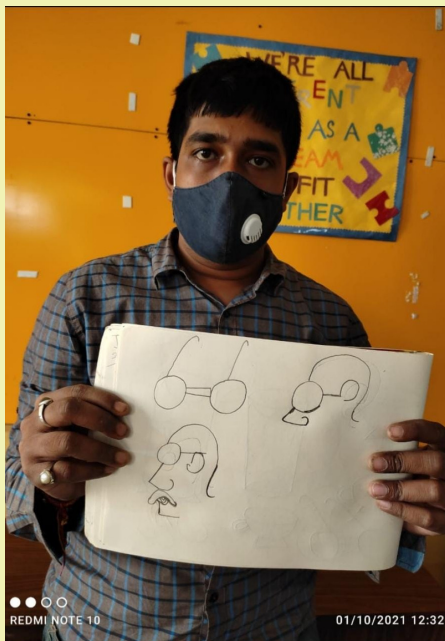
Other activities like grooming, home and personal care, basic cooking skills, daily exercises, sports, speech therapy, physiotherapy and behavior management were introduced virtually. These activities are regularly modified and improved on regular intervals to keep up with the children.

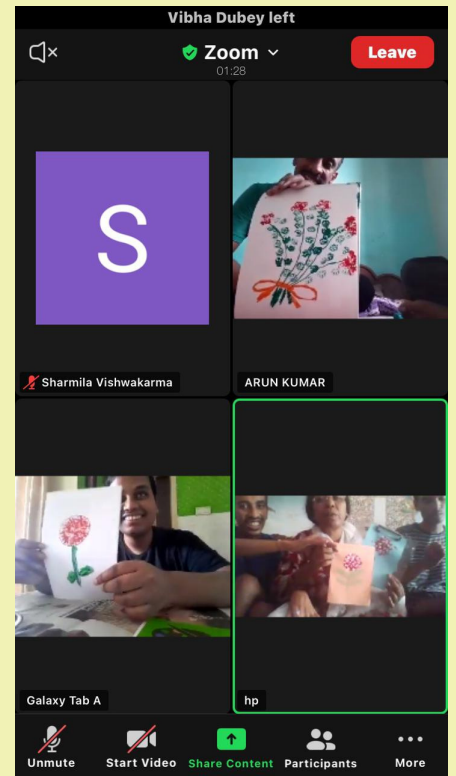
