OUTDOOR CLINIC

In-charge: Uma Sengupta, Director Clinical Services

Every Child with special needs is welcomed and given personal attention. We try to focus on the abilities which is used to overcome the delayed developments. Every year 250-300 children benefit from these services, recently we included deafblindness also. Working with multiple disability has been a learning experience. It has been observed that children who do not get exposure to physical activity and play develop sensory issues because their vestibular, proprioceptive receptors are not well trained. Also, malnutrition children have recurrent upper respiratory tract infections and cardiac problems and hence poor physical growth because of recumbencey in bed.

Early Intervention services are provided to children of 0-6 years of age. Children having developmental delay are given intensive therapeutic intervention. Along with physiotherapy, speech therapy, special education, behavior therapies, the parents are trained to provide therapies to the child. This gives faster results.

Success Story

Md. Ali Khursheed was 5 yrs. 9 months when he came to Deepshikha with quadriplegia (both legs and arms are effected), poor neck holding and not able to sit and speak.

After 7 months of therapy he is now able to sit by himself, speaks and tries to do motor activities.

Success Story

Ayansh Roshan was 3 yrs. 8 months when he came to Deepshikha.

For six months Speech therapy, Occupational therapy, Special Education and behavior therapy was given. Now the child responds to instructions and communicates his needs. Steady progress is observed in his misarticulation.

Individualized Education Plan (IEP) as the name suggests is a plan designed for each child as per the need. Sometimes results are delivered in just a few sessions. In some cases they take a lot of time.

Success Story

Harsh Mangla came to Deepshikha in 2022, unable to speak, had problems in understanding, sensory problems, Poor eye contact, and poor sitting tolerance. After 46 IEP sessions, Harsh is now able to make good eye contact and can now sit meaningfully for 35 minutes. He now expresses his needs verbally. He is now able to read and is going to a play school.

The aim of Pre-School programme is to prepare children for mainstream. We believe in the holistic development of the child. It includes Vestibular, Proprioceptive, and other sensory integration which is very important to develop the child into socially adaptable individual. Our primary focus is on communication, socialization, ADL skills, sensory integration along with other therapies which help in the mainstreaming of the child.

Success Story

Aarushi came to Deepshikha when she was just 2 yrs. old having poor social & communication skills, poor eye contact, delayed developmental milestones, poor sittings tolerance, attention deficit and right hemiplegia. The family came from Bero, one hour away from Ranchi, and after just 49 sessions she is able to hold objects, move her hands up and down, specially the right hand. The girl who could not even sit is now walking independently. There is significant control on drooling and has started sucking juice with straw, speaks 'Mumma' and 'Papa'. Uses gestures and finger to identify. She can now add 1 to 10, recognizes alphabets and colours. She is now going to Little Heart Play School, Bero.

Divided into classes preparatory, class 1, Class 3 and class 10, the school unit has adopted the NIOS curriculum and runs under that pattern now.

Hindi, English, Maths, Computer, EVS subjects are also taught.

Besides the regular curriculum on ADL, Yoga, Dance, Art and Craft, Social behaviors, Communication. Speech therapy and Physiotherapy is provided regularly.
