## **Out Door Clinic**

Deepshikha OPD Services have now developed into one of the best multisensory, multidisciplinary, therapeutic service unit in Jharkhand. The number of new registration however remains almost at par with last 3 or 4 years. However, this year the number of self referral have increased indicating the increased awareness about disability and services given at Deepshikha.

Out of 275 newly registered children, 97 had mental retardation and co-morbid conditions; 75 global developmental delay; 23 with delayed speech and language, 19 with cerebral palsy. But what draws our attention is the increase in the number of children with autism. We have registered 17 children with Autism spectrum Disorder.

To provide quality services to children with Autism we have started a multisensory therapy unit with guidance of Ms. Rosie Whitworth, a VSO volunteer from England who is an occupational therapist.

The follow up services in the OPD have increased and parents are proving to be very good partners in planning, assessing and executing services.


Annual Day Celebration: 22<sup>nd</sup> July

#### **❖** Toy Library:

A toy library was started for the overall development of the students. A number of educational and fun toys are kept here. Through these toys they learn various social and cognitive skills like sharing, group behavior, shape and size, colour, eye-hand co-ordination, fine motor, attention etc. These skills help junior students in classroom activities also. The overall concept is based on Montessori Method of learning.

Some students have learnt the rules of different games. They take permission from concerned teacher to use the toys and return on time. Thus they are learning two important skills:-

- To maintain time
- To own responsibility to submit the toys in good condition at the right place.

- Some of the children learn typing on computer. This skill helps the students in AMBA Classes also.
