From the Executive Director's desk....

The year 2010-11 was another year of achievements and developments, not only at Deepshikha, but also at State level.

This was the year that Dr. Alka Nizamie received the Best Professional Award by The National Trust for her services and contribution to the disability sector! We are extremely proud of her!

It was a year where due to convergence within State Departments we could achieve milestones which would have been otherwise unreachable. The first among these was the convergence with the Jharkhand Education Project (HRD) for Badhte Kadam 2010 which made it a huge success! It also witnessed a turnout of more than 2000 school children, including children with special needs, to celebrate the 2010 World Disability Day! As the State Nodal Centre for Disabilities (Dept. Of HRD) we were also able to do a lot of training for mainstream school teachers, resource teachers, technicians and caregivers.

This year due to our networking with the Jharkhand Viklang Manch we had an extremely successful Job Fair in Jamshepur. For the first time in Jharkhand, persons with various kinds of disabilities were given jobs. More than 100 PWDs were recruited in one day. We thank the major participating companies: AEGIS, Tata Steel, Deepak Printers, Clean Boy, and Ravi IAS Coaching Centre, and hope that we can repeat this exercise again. And I promise you, the placements will be even better!

'Utkarshi', the shop at Deepshikha, which was started with support from SAIL in 2009, continues to train children from Deepshikha in basic skills of marketing and of running a shop. The old clothes project has picked up and people in the neighbourhood now look forward to 'new' stocks of old clothes. The production of Diyas and Cards in the Skill Training & Production unit is rising. And thanks to the efforts of the volunteers, we are able to market them successfully as well! As a result we are able to hand out better remunerations to the children, helping them take their 'first step' towards self reliance!

Ankit Raj, a young boy with cerebral palsy, is through his last semester of engineering from Kalinga Institute of Technology. We thank Purshree members and the Abhijeet Group for sponsoring part of his fees.

There is good news for aspiring rehabilitation professionals! The Minorities Welfare Department is now recognizing D.Ed-SE-MR. They are offering scholarships through its Minorities Welfare Fund to students pursuing this course. We hope that this initiative will help committed and well deserving students to pursue this exciting and challenging career.

The State Disability Policy, which we helped to draft with the help of other NGOs and State Disability Commissioner, has now got clearance from the Cabinet. We expect that with a few amendments, it will come into force. Deepshikha also organised a State Level Consultation of the new Disability Act. Stakeholders, NGO representatives and Govt. officials and came up with a number of suggestions.

Inching towards an 'inclusive society', we are happy that a few schools have started opening their doors to children with special needs. They are also welcoming special children to participate and play together.

This year, thanks to the National Trust, we were able to start a 40 bed hostel for training purpose. We thank all our network partners, donors, well wishers, and volunteers for coming this far with us. With their support we hope to achieve many more milestones...

Monthly Meetings

At Deepshikha, the management and the staff come together for a monthly meetings, usually held on the first Saturday of every month. Each unit Incharge presents her report, interesting anecdotes and cases. Problems are also discussed and planning/ targets are set for the next month.

Out Patient Department

Working with children with different abilities, their assessment, planning, therapy, counseling of children and parents, school integration, providing guidance on govt. schemes and concessions, motivating parents, are part of the routine activities.

We try to improve skills and services to live up to the child's needs but the challenges are always there, specially when it comes to children with Autism. These children require very personal and structured environment which we try to meet through Individualized Education Programme.

The highlights of the programme are

- Knowing the child from within
- Behavioral therapy
- Weaning off from mother
- The programme is a learning experience for the mothers also
- Increasing attention span and eye to eye contact of the child
- To identify the likes and dislikes of the child which are used as rewards and punishment

Among the 284 beneficiaries, 125 came for regular follow up in various units.

Significant improvement was seen in

- **Gunjan, a slow learner, has now cleared the final exams with 65% marks.**
- **Tauheed, Ritesh and Oman, who attend pre-school services, have shown significant improvement in all areas.**
- **Tania Kar, having autism, has shown a lot of behavioral changes.**

Epilepsy Clinic

Resident trainees of CIP continue to do medical checkup and provide psychiatric and epilepsy consultation for children at the outdoor clinic. Weekly epilepsy clinic on every Wednesday is held at Namkum. This helps us to identify any medical emergency and to have regular follow up.

Pre-School

Small children come to Deepshikha to play and learn and to develop physical and cognitive skills. Children join at a very preliminary stage of life but after a few months of therapy, play, behavior modification and training in ADL, barring academics, they work at par with their peer group.

Sujal came running, held the teacher's hand, and led her out of the class room to the place where shoes are kept, indicating that she takes off her shoes.

This course, now conducted by IGNOU, with recognition from The Rehabilitation Council of India, not only gives an understanding of the special needs of the children who are challenged, but is also providing excellent avenues for employment. NIMH Project

The National Institute for Mentally Handicapped, Secunderabad (NIMH) is developing a tool for intellectual assessment. To test the tool, ten centers were chosen across the country. Deepshikha was one of the centers chosen in the eastern zone.

The project was for a period of one month in March 2011. Three people were involved in the project: Dr. Alka Nizamie as the supervisor; Mrs. Neena Agrawal and Mr. Sanjay Bhokta, both clinical psychologists, were involved as research associates. Mr. Sanjay Bhokta attended a training program on 'Tool for intellectual assessment for professionals' in NIMH, Secunderabad on 1st March 2011.

Thereafter, the tool was tested on 504 children from various schools in Ranchi. An equal number of male and female children were selected for the study. The age range was between 3 to 20 years. 36 mentally challenged children from Deepshikha were also selected for the study. The schools included were Loreto Convent, Holy Cross, Government Middle School, Karamtoli, Government High School, Bariatu, and Middle School, Chadri.

The tool comprised of oral questions and simple tasks.

STATE NODAL AGENCY CENTRE OF NATIONAL TRUST, JHARKHAND

April 2010- March 2011

Deepshikha as the State Nodal Agency Centre (SNAC) of National Trust made efforts to change attitudes among parents, siblings, community members, professionals, government officials and other stakeholders to strengthen and improve the quality of life of CWSNs in the State.

Activities, including workshops, training programmes, awareness creation and meetings undertaken by us as the SNAC, Jharkhand :

1. State Level Coordination Committee (SLCC) Meeting:

Three SLCC meetings were conducted to initiate pro active measures regarding disability issues in the State. Some of the outcomes of the meetings:

- The State Disability Policy has been drafted and approved by the cabinet.
- Process for single window system has been started.
- Steps are being taken to make LLCs more functional.
- Letters have been issued to the departments to spend 3% of their funds on disability.

Dates on which the meetings were held: 3rd July,2010, 13th September, 2010 and 28th March,2011

2. Meeting with LLC and Convergence with SNAPs: 21st Feb., 2011

One meeting was held with SNAPs and LLC-NGO member to know the developments of LLCs and activities of SNAPs in their respective districts. With 10 participants representing the NGOs, there was discussion on Niramaya, MIS, Guardianship and other issues.



3. Badhte Kadam : 19th Nov to 25th Nov 2010.

This event aimed to create a nationwide awareness on UNCRPD, National Trust and its schemes. 8 districts were covered in collaboration with the Jharkhand Education Project Council. More than ten thousand people were reached during this Campaign. The districts covered were Ranchi, Gumla, Lohardaga, Latehar, Hazaribagh, Bokaro and Ramgarh. (See detailed report).

4.Community Sensitization Programme for Medical professionals: 4th October,2010.

One day orientation training for Medical professionals conducted with the aim to develop a good network, the importance of identification of disabilities at an early stage, various clinical and developmental issues related to disability rehabilitation. For its success the National Rural Health Mission was contacted. Mrs. Aradhana Patnayak, IAS, and Director, NRHM send 30 PHC Doctors to participate. She was also the Chief Guest on the occasion.



5.SNAC –SNAP Meeting:

Four SNAC- SNAPs Meetings were conducted to develop a strategic plan for LLC and the implementation of NT schemes. Various pro active initiatives on issues related to Niramaya, MIS, Gyan Prabha, and Guardianship to implement the scheme at ground level were discussed.

Dates on which meetings were held : 1st May, 28th August ,20th December, 2010 and 21st Feb 2011.



6. Meeting of Registered NGOs of the State and SNAC/SNAPs: 2nd November, 2010

A State Level Meeting of NGOs were organized. 20 participants attend the meet. Status of schemes and provision for the disabled were discussed. Sharing of experience took place and ideas to make the schemes work were collected.

7. State Consultation on the New Disability Law: 7th and 8th March 2011

The two days consultation on the New Disability Law was organized at HPDC Ranchi by SNAC in association of Jharkhand Viklang Manch. The consultation was divided into two segments. On day I, the focus was on the concept and highlights of New Disability Law. On the second day the participants collected all ideas and suggestions to be incorporated in the new law. Mrs. Poonam Natarajan, Chairperson of The National Trust, Shri Satish Chandra, the State Disability Commissioner, Sudha Lhila, Executive Director, Deepshikha, Dr. Alka Nizamie, Arun Singh, President, Jharkhand Viklang Manch, Vivek Kr. Singh, Secretary, JVM were present as facilitators.

There were 75 participants from 20 districts of Jharkhand.

8. Organizational Development: 11th and 12th June 2010

One programme on Organizational Development was conducted for the Heads of NGOs. Aimed to develop skills in planning and execution of disability issues in their respective areas, participants reported that this training will help them in strategic planning and to develop competencies. Mrs. Sonali Nandi from IICP, Kolkata, Sri K.K. Bhagat from XISS, Ranchi were the resource persons. 30 participants attended the workshop.

9. Capacity Building Workshop: 14th to 17th July 2010

Four days Capacity Building workshop was organized at KGVK, Gurukul, Ranchi. Michael Rosenkrantz and Florance Mannikan, VSO volunteers with The National Trust, were the resource persons. 35 participants received training aimed to build capacities of the NGOs in raising funds for their various activities. KGVK is an Agricultural Project run by the Usha Martin Group of Companies. Mr. B.K.Jhawar, Vice President of the group addressed the participants and promised monetary support to deserving organizations.

10. Job Fair and Ability Mela: 3rd September 2011

More than 100 persons with disabilities (PWDs) got jobs at Job Fair and Ability Mela organised by Deepshikha and Jharkhand Viklang Manch at Jamshedpur under a National Trust initiative on 3rd Sept., 2010.

The Job Fair, organised at Michel John Auditorium, Bistupur saw an unexpected turnout of around 1100 PWDs against an expected turnout of around 500 PWDs. PWDs Participated from 14 districts of Jharkhand.

Ms. Himani Pandey, Deputy Commissioner, E. Singbhum, was the Chief Guest. She was accompanied by the DSWO, Shri S. P. Verma. The Secretary of the District Legal Aid Society, Shri B.B. Singh was also invited to speak on the legislations on Disability.



Shri Satish Pillai, Chief of TSRDS, of Tata Steel appreciated the efforts of the organisers. He presented mementoes to the organisations participating in the Job Fair.

Deepshikha, Ranchi had been entrusted with the responsibility to coordinate and organize the campaign in Jharkhand. Besides the Chief Guest, Smt. 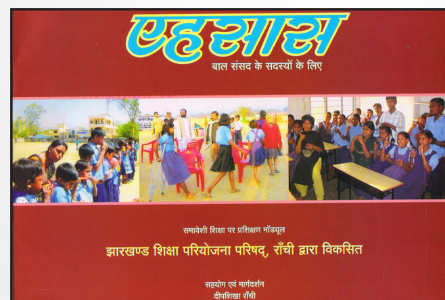
